Inasmuch as the lake township board felt it was advisable to take some action to prevent any further such hazards being created within our township.

"They did at their last regular meeting pass an ordinance whereby no one would be allowed to use a hydraulic dredge or other earthmoving equipment for the purpose of removing sand from the lake along the shore of our township within the distance of 1000 feet from shore, and in no case in less than 6 feet of water, thereby eliminating any hazard to the public".

It is the desire of the board to prevent further drownings and destruction of valuable lake frontage as well as unfavorable publicity for Houghton Lake in general, and the board hopes with the co-operation of the property owners in Lake Township that it will not be necessary to enforce this ordinance.
