

Spongy Moth Suppression / Aerial Spraying

Upon review of the data that our survey team collected during the months of August, September, October and November of 2025, it has been determined that there will be no Spongy Moth treatment in the Spring of 2026.

The low egg mass counts observed by our survey crews do not meet the minimum threshold for treatment. This is due in part to previous suppression efforts conducted by the county, as well as Spongy Moth outbreaks being cyclical by nature. The last time we had low numbers and did not conduct suppression activities was in 2016.

Our survey crew will continue to monitor the hatching of observed egg masses and document any noticeable defoliation throughout the spring and early summer months. We strongly encourage all residents to report on any Spongy Moth activity experienced in their area and to implement best management practices where appropriate.
